PASSPORT within striking distance along inside, came around rivals three wide into stretch, gained command mid stretch, kept to task, prevailed. CAPTAIN BUCKY was never far back along rail, responded to handling, went gamely and was gaining on leader in late going. DIAMANTE DE ORO hustled to front, set pace with a clear lead into stretch, went gamely under pressure in drive before weakening late. GENERAL PARKS trailed for half, commenced bid racing five wide into stretch, finished with a mild mid track rally. SHARE CROPPER well back for half, improved positioned along inside. SLEEVE failed to menace. MR. PURSUIT stalked leaders from outset, came four wide into lane, gave way. ROTARY chased pace into stretch, faded. PURE PANICK was outrun.
