SEQUOIA CHARM stalked the early pace from the inside, tracked the pace up the backstretch, altered outside for the drive and wore down rivals the final furlong to be clear late. COSMIC BAKER dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled through the drive but could not match strides late. GARBU AND SHE pressed the early pace from the outside, dueled through the drive but was outfinished for the place. LADY BE GOLD dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged entering the second turn, held a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. CHASIN GYPSY could only pass tired ones. CUTE STORM was no factor. TWO BUCKS A SONG was no threat. WILDPLAY forced the early pace outside and tired.
