Footnotes

DO THE TIGER stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, made a bid entering the drive and was clear late while kept to task. BORDER SLEW hopped at the start, chased the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, responded but could not keep pace.

MAYMEISTER far back early, advanced outside, responded when sat down for the drive but could only gain the show. SERAZZELL broke out at the start bumping with outside rivals, chased the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the drive and finished well. POMEROY GIRL pressed the early pace from between foes but had nothing left for the drive. CAROL'S GIFT was bumped at the start and no factor. CUVÉE BLANC was no threat. LET'S DREAM AGAIN dueled from the outside and tired. QUEEN OF THE POOL broke in at the start bumping with rivals and was no factor. MACKEE'S LAST TRICK pressed the early pace inside and tired. MAMES' GAME dueled from the inside and gave way. SKEETER GAL was crowded at the start and was never close. JERSEY SHORE GIRL was outrun early, advanced inside, clipped heels entering the drive and fell and walked off. After a Stewards' Inquiry there was no change.
