Footnotes

DIXIE MOUNTAIN broke to front, dueled on narrow lead for half, shook loose into lane, kept to task in drive while increasing margin. TRULY GONE WILD stalked leaders from outset, came three wide into lane when making bid, no match for winner in drive but best of others. DREAMS D'ORO forward positioned along inside, lacked response when asked. CHARLIE TUNA chased leader for half, gave way. NAPI forwardly positioned from start, came four wide into stretch, failed to menace. WEBBER well back early, swung six wide into lane, not a factor. SCENE CONTROL was not a threat. KILATES KISS showed little. WEBCAST was always outrun. BOOT PATROL forwardly positioned along inside early, dropped back before half mile. MAJESTIC MON was never close.
