SOULFUL SILVER within striking distance outside rivals from outset, came three wide around rivals into stretch, responded to take command and draw off in late going. ILE ST. ROSIE hustled to front, set pace with clear lead into stretch, went gamely in drive before weakening in late going. MOTEL TAN was never far back, raced four wide when making bid into stretch, flattened out. GIACOMINA stalked leaders along rail into stretch, gave way. GUANABARA GAL well back at the half, improved position while mid track in lane. JANIES SONG stalked leaders from outset, moved up to engage leaders at the half, gave way in lane. WAR BONNET raced in middle of pack along inside from outset, failed to menace. SAINTED GLORY was never a factor. WINGO was never a threat. QUEEN'S ISSUE wide from outset, showed little. DANCE CATER DANCE was outrun. QUITE SHARP was never close.
