BARNEY R stalked leaders from outset, came three wide when making bid into stretch, responded to handling, took over mid stretch, drew clear in late going. WILD FOR GLORY chased pace on the outside from outset, responded to gain narrow lead into stretch, went gamely but unable to match strides with winner in late going. DUAL FORECAST was never far back, raced four wide into stretch, finished with a mild mid track rally. HOYA broke to front, set pace for half, went gamely under pressure into stretch, tired. TRICKY CAUSEWAY stalked leaders along inside into stretch, had no rally. MONEYONTHEGRASS raced in middle of pack, lacked response when asked. ALERIC was not a factor. MR. BARRY broke through gage ;pre-start, never threatened. STAND WATIE showed little. NUMISMATIST forwardly positio0ned wide of rivals into stretch, faded. WACO HUG was outrun. COWBOY CADILLAC was never close.
