ALL PROFIT dueled from outset along rail, gained narrow advantage at the half, went gamely under pressure throughout stretch run and prevailed in a gutsy effort. LEALLAH'S ANTHONY within striking distance along inside for half, came off rail four wide into lane when making bid, engaged leader mid stretch, went gamely to wire and just missed. MARK HIS WORD came five wide from middle of pack into lane, responded with a mid track rally to gain show spot. RADIOACTIVE GROOM commenced bid racing six wide from middle of pack, moved up to loom threat mid stretch, flattened out. PURE PANICK well back at the half, improved position in lane. STREET RACER forwardly positioned along inside to stretch, had no rally. ECKHART stalked leaders into stretch, gave way. JOHNNY GRINGO raced along inside and never a factor. DAVMAR TWO hustled to front, dueled for half, faded. DADS PRIDE raced along rail into lane, never threatened. SMARTY'S BRUSH was always outrun. SUPER MASONIC was never close, eased in lane, crossed finish.
