Footnotes

APTOBEFIRST broke to front, set pace into stretch, kept to steady urging during stretch run and increased margin to wire. PACAR was allowed to settle in stride for half, came four wide into lane, finished with a belated rally to gain second spot. SLIPPING SLIGO stalked leaders from outset, no threat to top pair, but went gamely to gain show money. MUSTANG BOB stalked leaders from outset, moved nearest pace three quarter call, gave way. DOITFORJOHNNY was well back from outset, failed to menace. ALLEYS GENERAL well back for three quarters, passed tiring foes. PHONE ETHICS raced in middle of pack and never a factor. HONOUR CHRISSIE chased pace for half, faded. CUPID'S GLANCE saved ground while well back from start to no avail. FARE CIELO stalked leaders for three quarters, dropped back. HOLLYWOOD STORM along inside throughout, never threatened. FLYING G fractious loading, never close, eased in lane, crossed finish.
