CHASIN DREAMS allowed to settle along inside for half, came around rivals leaving far turn, five wide into stretch, responded with a burst of energy to take command and draw off in late going. SYMPHONY OF PSALM chased pace from outset, responded to gain clear advantage mid stretch, went gamely but unable to hold off rush of winner in final stages. WINE DIVA was never far back, finished with a solid belated rail rally. CLASSIC ACTRESS stalked pace from outset, responded to be nearest leaders mid stretch, tired. ANSONG well back after a half, lacked the needed late response when asked. SIRRAH trailed for half, failed to menace. GAME N LAUGHIN' hustled to front, set pace for half, went gamely before giving way mid stretch. PHOENICIAN MOON was not a factor. EMMA GRACE was not a threat. WILD INDIAN was outrun. STRAWBERRY CHASE stalked leaders for half, dropped back.
