OFFICER SHIPLEY hesitated at the start, was outrun early, advanced from the outside up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive and was just up the final strides. LINDA CAROL'S SLEW up close early from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, dueled through the second turn, gained a short advantage at the eighth pole but was caught the final strides. NORTHWOOD FLYER stalked the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded but could not match strides. BEST DAY (MEX) far back early, advanced from the outside entering the second turn, responded and had good energy late. ARKY PEACH pressed the early pace from the inside, responded entering the drive and finished well but too late. IT'S ON HOLMES chased the early pace inside and tired. KIPALONG CACHE forced the early pace from the outside, dueled through the second turn then tired. TRITICALE dueled from the outside and tired. SPANISH PRIDE was never close. PASS EM KRISTIN was no threat. SLEWDEMAJOR dueled from the inside and gave way. ROGER'S STAR had a steady retreat.
