HAPPYTOBEKING dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained forward entering the turn, responded when asked and was along in time. DANDY DIAMOND dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, battled through the stretch but could not match strides. KING GUSTAUFG dueled from between foes for the early lead, battled through the turn, remained engaged through the drive but could not keep pace. FIRST TURNADO outrun early, steadily advanced outside, responded to pressure and had good energy late. RAY O ACK could only pass tired ones. TULSA

COUNTY chased the early pace outside but had nothing left for the drive. ALYSSA'S SEMORAN forced the early pace from the inside but had no late response. WILLIE RAY was no factor. CHIEF ELLIS was no menace. SHY DUTCH was no threat. LIONELONTHETRACKS forced the early pace and tired. DANCER DEE was never close. PURPLE TRADER showed little.
