### Footnotes

SLEEVE was allowed to settle early, commenced bid racing five wide into lane, responded to strong handling to gain command and draw clear in late going. STRAIGHT FLASH was never far back along rail, responded to handling into stretch to loom danger mid stretch, no match for winner but clearly second best. FIRST GUESS well back along rail, came off rail four wide when making bid top stretch, finished with a mild rally. CHILE FRITO stalked leaders on the outside into stretch, gave way. MAE B TODAY failed to menace. WYNN STORMY hustled to front, set pace to mid stretch, gave way. LUMPY'S ACE chased pace for half, gave way. SHOTGUN RYDER was never a factor. ALL READY forwardly positioned for half, dropped back. TWO TIMIN SLEW always outrun.
