TIMELY PURSUIT was never far back, commenced bid three wide of rivals into stretch, responded to steady handling to gain command and draw clear in late going. PUCKSTER within striking distance from outset, moved up along rail into stretch, gained narrow edge mid stretch, flattened out in late going. BRIAN G was allowed to settle in stride early, came four wide into lane, finished with a mild mid track rally to gain show spot. MOJO WORKIN well back at the half, raced five wide into lane, improved position. TIZ READY well back at the half, passed tiring foes. TIZ BIZ dueled on the outside of rival from start, responded to gain advantage at the half, went gamely to stretch, gave way. TENSAW was not a factor. DOC HEATH dueled along rail for half, faded. BARRAAQ forwardly positioned along inside for half, dropped back. RING IT UP wide from outset, never seriously threatened. MUCHO MACHO UNO was through early.
