LITTLE WAGON rated off early pace, circled leaving far turn, willingly came three wide to take over into stretch, unchallenged, ridden out to wire. ALERIC was allowed to settle for the first mile, came three wide when making bid into stretch, no match for winner but clearly best of others. B G ROYAL WEST well back from outset, improved position in lane. PURSUE A DREAM stalked leaders into stretch, gave way. SLEW BY SLEW chased early pace, responded to gain nod at the mile marker, went gamely into stretch, faded in lane. STEEL BLUE SLEW was never a threat. MIDWAY TAP hustled to front before half half, dropped back steadily thereafter.
