WASHITA GAMBLER chased pace from outset, responded to take over at the half, went unchallenged during stretch run, ridden out while increasing margin. F C TONIGHT I RIDE was never far back, came four wide into stretch, no match for winner, but went gamely to gain second spot. LUCKY SON OF A GUN came five wide from middle of pack into lane, moved up to nearest leader mid stretch, tired in drive but well clear of others. KINGOFTINGS well back for half, swung six wide into stretch, failed to menace. RIDGE ROAD forwardly positioned half, lacked response in drive. SUPREME LOVER hustled to front, set pace for half, gave way. LOST GULCH stalked leaders for half, dropped back. COWBOY KEITH was never a threat. SUMROCK was outrun.
