BOGALUSA broke sharp from the inside to gain the early margin, remained clear entering the turn, widen the effort at the eighth pole and was well clear while kept to task. BELLE MUSE outrun early, advanced inside entering the turn, responded along the rail and had good energy late. BRINKS BABY up close early from the inside, held a forward position for the drive but could not match strides. CIRCUSTOWN ROSE forced the early pace from the outside, remained forward but had no late response. BOUVIER went evenly. BEFUDDLER chased the early pace outside but had nothing left. ROMA JEAN forced the early pace and tired. EASTER BUNNY BABE was no factor. SHANIA TWANG was never close. SERENA VENUS showed little.
