DESTIN TO REIGN was allowed to settle for half, circled leaving far turn, came six wide into stretch, responded to steady urging while mid track, took over and drew clear in late going. LOOKSLIKEAHIT rated off early pace along inside, moved up to engage leader mid stretch, went gamely but unable to match strides with winner late. RUNAWAY PEPPER was never far back outside foes, came three wide into lane, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, flattened out. IMHEREFORAGOODTIME stalked leaders from outset, responded to gain narrow edge mid stretch, gave way in late going. JEWELRYHIESTER well back early, improved position. ROCK THIS BAR hustled to front, set pace for half, faded. GENTLE OCEAN trailed at the half, passed tiring foes. STONE HARBOUR stalked leaders on the outside for half, faded. BALUARTE broke alertly, dropped back after quarter mile. INCLINED TO WIN vied for early lead along inside, faded steadily after half. RED SHOES never threatened. DEPUTY FOREST was outrun.
