DRILL STEM rated off early pace, commenced bid leaving far turn, came four wide into stretch, responded to steady handling, got up in final strides. CANNON CLASS chased pace from outset, responded to gain advantage mid stretch, went gamely to wire only to be outnodded in the end. SLEWDAZZLE hustled to front, dueled along rail into stretch, went gamely under pressure during stretch run only to be outfinished. AMERICA'SGRANDSLAM well back early, moved forwardly into far turn, came five wide into stretch, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, hung in late going. OKIE PROSPECT in back early, moved forward to reach contention into stretch, had no rally. HUMMERS AHUMIN stalked leaders for half, gave way. KING DALTON well back at the half,

improved position. WELLSTON was never a factor. A J'S CAT showed little. MISTER VAQUERO saved ground while forwardly positioned early, faded. M L YAHOO was never a threat. RAFFY raced forwardly along inside for quarter mile, dropped back. EL RELANPAGO was always outrun.
