JACKPOT JOSIE broke to front, rated well with narrow lead into stretch, was kept to steady urging throughout stretch drive to prove best. IS THAT SO well back early, circled leaving far turn, swung eight wide into stretch, finished with a solid mid track rally to gain second spot. SAINTLY ONE chased pace into stretch, went gamely before weakening in late going. BEFUDDLER raced in middle of pack from outset, racing four wide into stretch, lacked response when asked in drive. MS DIXIE DOLLAR was allowed to settle in stride while wide of rivals from start, came six wide into lane, failed to menace. SWEET CONSOLIDATOR forwardly positioned outside rivals from outset, lacked response when asked. ANSWER THE OFFICER well back from start, raced seven wide into lane, not a factor in drive. EASY TOUCH raced along inside, showed little. CALL POPPIE stalked leaders for half, gave way. ADDISON TRAIL never threatened. SUNNY SILVER dueled while between foes for half, dropped back. MORGAN'S MISSY was always outrun.
