SUNSET RIDER was allowed to settle in stride during early running, commenced bid circling foes leaving far turn, came four wide into stretch, took command mid stretch, kept to task, remained clear. IRISH LUCK rated off early pace along inside, moved up leaving far turn, came three wide into stretch, challenged leader mid stretch, no match for winner but well clear for second spot. GREY LONE WOLF trailed for half, commenced bid circling rivals leaving far turn, came four wide into stretch, finished with a belated mid track rally. HOYA broke to front, set pace for three quarters, held well to mid stretch, gave way. QUIET KING stalked leaders into stretch, dropped back. CHIEF TWO SPOTS was not a factor. Q AND A forwardly positioned for half, faded. LUCKY RAJA chased pace into stretch, faded.
