DIXIE HEARTH well positioned from outset, came around rivals four wide into stretch, responded to steady handling, got up in final strides. HALF A DIAMOND chased leader from outset, responded to gain advantage mid stretch, went gamely under pressure in drive only to be outnodded in the end. HIDDEN GOLD stalked leaders along rail from outset, moved up smartly along rail into stretch, in tight top stretch, forced to steady, losing all chance. THUNDER HOOKEY hustled to front, set pace for half, gave way. TEENIE well back at the half, improved position. ONCE A QUEEN failed to menace. SARAVA'S SENSATION was never a factor. KIBLING was not a threat. PUCKER UP BABY was outrun. O K FUNNY FACE trailed throughout.
