This race will be limited to 12 starters. Preference: Stakes winning or stake-placed horses in graded/group stakes (in order I,II,III), then lifetime earnings. Lifetime earnings will be determined according to statistics provided by Equibase. Trophy to the winning Owner.

Footnotes

TED'S FOLLY outrun early, steadily advanced outside up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive and was along in time. RECKLESS JERRY up close early from the inside, dueled through the second turn, remained engaged through the drive but could not match strides. PEE H DEE dueled from between foes for the early lead, battled up the backstretch, remained engaged through the second turn but could not keep pace. NO SPIN stalked the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced entering the second turn, responded but could not sustain the effort. FIRE ALARM went evenly. BASALT forced the early pace and tired. PLEASANT CLOSING was no factor. STRONG RESOLVE went evenly. SEEKER dueled from the inside and tired. ALTERNATIVE was never close. MR BLUEGRASS MUSIC was no threat. FLASHY KID dueled from the outside and gave way.
