DOTTIE BOOTH rated off early pace, commenced bid racing outside rivals leaving far turn, came four wide into stretch, responded to steady urging while racing mid track, got up in time. **NOBLE BANDIT** well back along rail early, moved up along rail leaving far turn, came three wide into stretch, responded to gain narrow edge mid stretch, went gamely before weakening in late going. **EXPECT DIAMONDS** was never far back, moved up four wide into stretch, loomed danger mid stretch, flattened out. **HEART ACK ROAD** well back after the half along inside, swung five wide into stretch, failed to menace. **SPECIAL OCCASION** hustled to front, set pace for half, gave way. **LADY GDANSKI** chased pace for half, dropped back. **OSWEGO** was thru early, outrun.
