GO TIGER JACK within striking distance outside of rivals from outset, swung five wide into stretch, responded to gain edge mid stretch, kept to task, remained clear to wire. RANSOM ROBERTO was never far back along inside, responded to gain narrow advantage into stretch, bore out mid stretch, strike

rivals head with whip repeated during late going, clear second. ELUSIVE SCHEMES trailed for half, came five wide when making bid into stretch, went gamely, impeded with rivals whip repeated during stretch drive. J J'S INDY well back while racing along inside, moved up forwardly into stretch, finished well with a strong stretch run. OUR SACRED HONOR within striking distance along inside into stretch, lacked response when asked. FLY'N LION well back early, four wide into lane, failed to menace. NO WALKIN' JOE was never a factor. DARK RULER raced along inside, showed little. RUNAWAY OKIE was never a threat. GLENBEIGH chased pace for half, faded. SOME QUICK was outrun. BERLIOZ stalked leaders for half mile, faded. RICH ELM hustled for front, set pace for half, dropped back suddenly.
