STAR POWER rated off pace along rail from outset, moved up smartly along rail into stretch, responded to gain slight edge mid stretch, went gamely under pressure to wire, prevailed. SCRAPPY ROO stalked leaders from outset, came four wide into stretch, responded with a solid rally but too late. SAINT'S RELIC stalked leaders from outset, lacked the needed rally during stretch drive. AGOSTO'S TUNE chased pace to mid stretch, weakened. PUTTHEHAMMERDOWN raced in middle of pack, had no rally. JUMP TO THE CHASE well back after a half, circled eight wide into stretch, finished well with belated rally. MAN CHESTER MAN raced in middle of pack, not a factor. WINDY LOU was never a threat. WINDING ROAD hustled to front, set pace for half, faded. KING GULCH was never a threat. H K'S VICTORY was always outrun.
