BLAZEN SUMMER allowed to settle in stride early, commenced bid leaving far turn outside rivals, five wide into stretch, responded to gain nod mid stretch, drew clear in late going. TUFF RUFF ANDREADY was never far back racing wide of rivals, came four wide into stretch, moved up to engage leader mid stretch, no match late for winner but well clear for second spot. LUCKSTELLALL allowed to settle early along rail, came off rail five wide into stretch, moved up to loom danger mid stretch while mid track, flattened out. IRISH LUCK stalked leaders along rail from start, forced to steady mid stretch when in tight. SUM MAN dueled with leaders to stretch, gave way. ADIOS SWEETIE failed to menace. TURBO KRIS hustled to front, set pace for half, faded. DYNAMICHAEL chased leader for half mile, faded. MOLLY'S MAZE was outrun.
