J J'S INDY dueled along rail from outset, responded to pressure throughout stretch run and prevailed in an all out effort. GOOD TO GREAT stalked leaders from outset, came three wide into stretch, responded to handling during drive only to outnoddod on the wire in a game try. MOSCOW ADVENTURE dueled on the outside of rivals from outset, gained narrow edge three quarter marker, went gamely under pressure during run to wire before weakening late. JUMPONTHEBANDWAGON allowed to settle in stride for half, came five wide into stretch, lacked needed response in drive. STATICE failed to menace. DREAMS D'ORO was not a factor. ASHEN LORD stalked leaders for three quarters, gave way. RED SHOES was never a threat. POSTTENSION was always outrun.
