MUST BE HE rated off early pace along inside, rallied along rail into stretch, responded to handling, split foes mid stretch, got up in time. CENTERFIELD stalked leaders from outset, came three wide when making bid, went gamely under steady urging in drive but unable to match strides with winner. SUSHI JOE chased pace into stretch, went gamely before weakening in late going. PRAY TELL allowed to settle in stride early, commenced bid racing five wide into stretch, finished with a belated mid track rally. SILVER HAZE trailed after a half, circled four wide into stretch, finished with a belated mid track rally. TRICKY JO raced in middle of pack throughout, failed to menace. PUTTHEHAMMERDOWN was never a factor. WHISKEY MAN hustled to front, set pace for three quarters, faded steadily in lane.
