LUCKY DOLLAR dueled on the outside of rivals from start, responded and shook loose entering stretch, kept to task during run to wire, remained clear. CAT MAN JACK rallied from middle of pack four wide into stretch, responded well in drive, gaining on leader in late going. I'M OUTA HERE was never far back, raced five wide into stretch, finished with a mild belated rally. P L CLASSIC RIVER raced along inside off pace, moved up at the half, loomed danger mid stretch, flattened out. RUSTY RED STAR stalked leaders along inside into stretch, had no rally. I'M FEELING LUCKY failed to menace. BOOMER RISK was not a factor. BONAFIDE STAR was not a threat. WHIRLING CREST dueled along rail from start, gained narrow edge at the half, faded in lane. TWISTAFIDE forwardly positioned for quarter mile, dropped back. SECRET IN THE WIND stalked leaders on the outside for half, faded steadily thereafter.
