SALTY CAL was never far back, came four wide when making bid into stretch, responded to steady urging in drive, got up in final strides. GREY KNIGHT chased pace from outset along rail, responded to handling to take clear advantage mid stretch, went gamely under pressure only to be outfinished on the wire. ROARING MAX well back early, raced four wide into lane, finished with a mild rally to gain show spot. LAST MINUTE JOE hustled to front, set pace for half, tired. MR. DIAMOND well back early, five wide into lane, failed to menace. WASPY CEE was not a factor. MARIA'S SIREN never threatened. SPECIAL CAST stalked leaders along rail, faded after quarter mile. CATO was never close. STORMING J W was outrun. MUSTANG BOB trailed early while far back, eased in lane. OLD SILVERHEAD forwardly positioned early, bolted far turn, pulled up.
