EIGHTY MILLION broke to front, set pace for half, lost advantage into stretch, responded to steady urging, came again, took command and drew clear in late going. FITZHUGH FLASH was never far back along inside, came three wide into lane, responded to handling but unable to reach winner in late going

and settled for second best. DEPUTY MAX chased pace on the outside from outset, went gamely to mid stretch, tired in late going. MONEY RULES was allowed to settle in stride while not far back along inside for half, swung four wide into lane when making bid, lacked late response in drive. TRINITY TAVERN stalked leaders from outset, had no rally. MEGARIDE came five wide from middle of pack when making bid into stretch, loomed threat mid stretch, flattened out. LE FLYING MONKEY rushed to contention, dueled into stretch, gave way. HOT DAMON well back at the half, improved position in lane. RYS ALLEY CAT failed to menace. C'EM BLAZIN was not a factor. I NEED A BALEOUT wide from outset, never a threat. HURRICANE DAY wide from start, showed little. PHARME LEGEND wide from outset, through early. MR. BARRY was always outrun.
