PYRO JO well positioned along rail, commenced bid under strong handling top stretch, wore down leader in final strides. FASHIONS BY DAVID was never far back while racing between foes early, swung five wide when making bid into lane, responded to steady urging in drive and just missed. LIL DITTY rushed up to duel for lead before half, opened clear advantage into stretch, went gamely before shortening strides in late going. OKIE DARB well back at the half, came four wide into lane, improved position, mid track. DARN GOOD raced along inside, failed to menace. MELLARK was unhurried for first half, swung six wide into lane, not a factor. AMY NICOLE stalked leaders into stretch, gave way. JOYOUS DANCER was not a threat. NURSE G was outrun. DIXIE DELTA hustled to early lead, dropped back steadily after half.
