CONCORDES SAINT set the early pace, drew clear to have a safe advantage into the stretch, was challenged late, dug in the final strides and held gamely. AX ME NICE was allowed to settle early racing four wide, went five wide into the stretch, rallied at the sixteenth pole, closed with a rush in the final strides and just missed. DOS AND DON'TS was within striking distance early racing three wide, placed a bid to close willingly but didn't have enough late and was outfinished for the show. SMOKIN' LEGEND was off slow early, vied five wide into the stretch and showed some interest late. SUMMERTIME SAL broke slowly, then saved ground, angled out three wide and showed some effort late. BONNDADDY'S pressed the early pace from the inside and was finished after a half. RUNNIN RED was forwardly placed early racing five wide then faded steadily. NO WALKIN' JOE made a move mid way then retreated. FLY'N LION saved ground throughout and gave way steadily.
