FUTURITY TRIAL Ruidoso Futurity Trials - Quarter Horse

FOR TWO YEAR OLDS THAT WERE NOMINATED AND REMAIN ELIGIBLE FOR THE 2011 RUIDOSO QUARTER HORSE

FUTURITY (G1). Weight: 120, lbs. All horses must enter for the trials on Sunday, May 22, 2011 by 10:00 am and pay the \$1,200 entry fee, if they are to run in the trials. Late nominations of \$15,000 (includes all fees) will be accepted until time of entry into the trials. Those who want to remain eligible for the 2012 Ruidoso Derby, but elect not to run in the 2011 Ruidoso Futurity time trials may do so if they are still eligible at the time of entry into the time trials, by paying the \$1,200 entry fee into the Ruidoso Futurity time trials. The ten fastest times from the trials will qualify for the final.
