**Footnotes**

BLUE JEAN'S WHO was allowed to settle early racing off the inside, angled out four wide at the three sixteenths, closed well with urging and was up in the final strides. KNOXVILLE GIN was unhurried early racing off the rail, angled out three wide between foes in mid stretch to rally, finished well but didn't have enough late and missed. KNOW WHEN TO RUN set the early pace drawing clear into the turn, was challenged in deep stretch, fought hard to the wire but was outfinished. OFFICER'S MATE broke outward at the break then chased the leader, drifted five wide in the stretch and weakened. KATAKAN stalked the early leaders along the rail saving ground then faded. DE HONKYTONKANGEL was off slow early saving ground and lacked a bid. VAQUERA AVENUE was outrun early, went four wide in the stretch and was not a threat.
