ATTILA ATTACK forced the early pace from the inside, sustained a bid to duel briefly, edged clear and widened in the stretch. SENOR PROSPECT dueled from between foes, failed to match strides with the winner but held the place. AZTHEHOTWALKTURNS dueled from the outside three wide and weakened after a half. FIRE E BEAN was unhurried early saving ground, angled out three wide near the three sixteenths and placed a mild bid. TRUE TO CHOPIN broke slow, saved ground and showed some interest late. MR ERIC chased the early leaders four wide and lacked a late effort. YOUR FLYING DUTCH was off slow early racing off the rail and improved his position in the stretch. POLISH GOLD dropped back early racing off the rail, angled three wide and passed tiring foes. HELIOBULL was outrun early, went three wide and was not a threat. W F WILDCAT saved ground to no avail.
