GRUBBY WHO forced the early pace saving ground, vied in deep stretch, surged clear and widened in the final strides. FIRST CLASS CABIN was unhurried early, sustained a bid four wide between rivals in the stretch and was just up for the place. ONE TOUGH HOMBRE set a pressured early pace three wide, was challenged nearing the quarter pole and yielded. BURBON ROAD was never far back saving ground, angled out into the stretch five wide and placed a mild effort late. WHATYOURGONNAGET pressed the early pace saving ground, gained the advantage, held to the eighth pole then was challenged and gave way. CINDERELLA KID raced wide throughout and failed to menace. WAGERMONEY HONEY raced wide and was not a factor. PRINCE CARSON broke sharply, settled into stride then faded steadily. KIDNEY BEAN trailed the field and was outrun.
