### Footnotes

ON STRIDE broke sharply to draw quickly clear, was challenged briefly, responded to pressure increased advantage. DISTORTED GOLD stalked the early leaders four wide, drifted out mid track in the stretch to rally and got up for the place. TULAROSA forced the early pace while saving ground and yielded in the drive. COLORS OF POMPEII pressed the early pace from between foes, was checked hard near the five sixteenths marker then dropped back and failed to recover. T NELL T was allowed to settle early racing off the inside, drifted mid track late and weakened. BREA was unhurried early four wide, angled in to save ground in the turn and lacked a rally. TEXAS HOTTIE trailed the field along the inside and was not a factor.
