JUST WAVE GOODBYE stalked the early leaders, loomed up four wide to gain a short lead, lost the advantage in the stretch, fought back to the wire and prevailed. KID CRAWFORD set the early pace drawing clear, was challenged in the stretch, battled back but was outfinished at the wire. DESERT DOME was unhurried early, rallied along the rail in the stretch and gained the show. TITANIUM HALO prompted the early pace three wide then weakened. HOLLYWOOD HARRY broke slow, placed a steady effort racing off the inside. GRANDAN raced mid pack and lacked a rally. PLEASANT BID was outrun early and lacked a late effort. SQUATTY BOB failed to threaten. THUNDER UNBRIDLED was forwardly placed early, dropped back and was not a factor.
