### Footnotes

SAINT ASHTON set the early pace drawing clear, was never challenged and increased his advantage to the wire. OCEANOR tracked the early leader from the inside, sustained a bid angling out three wide at the top of the stretch, was no match and followed the winner in the stretch. CACTUS COWBOY was within striking distance early three wide, placed a brief bid near the quarter pole then flattened in the stretch. CANDYMAN CAM was off slow early while saving ground and passed tiring foes in the stretch. SUNLAND SOUVENIR prompted the early pace, was between foes at the quarter pole then tired and faded in the stretch. PRESIDENT PAUL was off slow early and improved his position in the stretch. YRUNVS M. B. broke outward at the start, was outrun in the early going, dropped steadily back and was not a factor.
