WORKINGIRLSLEW was allowed to settle early, moved quickly up four wide to gain a short lead, battled to the wire and prevailed in the final strides. CHARMING MOVES forced the early pace from the inside, placed a bid in deep stretch, fought hard to the wire but was outfinished. ALL THE HARD WAYS was forwardly placed early between foes, was steadied into the turn, angled in along the rail and came back in the stretch. SEXY IN STILETTOS was unhurried early, vied five wide then flattened in the drive. ROLLINROLLINNDOUGH set the early pace from the outside and was finished after a half. VERY SHINEY was off slow, raced mid track in the stretch and placed a mild effort. W F DIAMOND HALO broke poorly, saved ground and was not a threat. OPENCONTAINER prompted the early pace racing off the rail then faded steadily. HOLY HALLORY was outrun early racing off the rail and was not a factor.
