Footnotes

YES HE'S A PISTOL was allowed to settle early, angled out into the turn, sustained a bid between in the stretch and wore down his rivals to prove best. DUNLAP was unhurried early, loomed up along the inside at the top of the stretch, gained a clear lead at the eighth pole and failed to last in the final yards. STRIKINOUT N MIAMI was within striking distance early, rallied in the stretch five wide and was gaining late. MY WIRE was outrun early, raced five wide placing a brief bid then flattened. DON'TCALLMEFARNUM pressed the early pace between foes and was finished after a half. DERBY ROAD was void of early speed, went four wide and placed a mild bid. GOLDEN CAPOTE was outrun early racing wide and passed tiring foes. WHERE'S THE DOUGH dueled from along the inside, was used up early and gave way. RUNAWAY WONDERCAT dueled from between foes, was used up and faded. GATO MONTES showed little in a dull effort. RATCHET forced the early pace then retreated steadily.
