DIABLA dueled from the outside, placed a bid drifting out in the stretch, was urged strongly left handed and was up in the final strides. SHEZ OUR INFLUENCE dueled from the inside, gained a clear advantage at the eighth pole but failed to last in the final yards. REAL COMIC was unhurried early saving ground, closed the gap into the stretch and was along for the show. SAFEWAY DAN was off slow early, went four wide in the turn and showed some effort late. MAGIQUE forced the early pace four wide, drifted in some near the eighth pole then weakened. MISS MARCOM prompted the early place from between rivals three wide, was steadied near the sixteenth and not asked in the late going. ICING broke slowly then dropped back and was not a factor.
