INDICATION N M stalked the early leaders four wide, placed a bid nearing the quarter pole, gained the lead at the eighth then kicked clear. MARTHAS PRINCESS was allowed to settle early, went five wide to rally into the stretch and closed well late. BACK SEAT ROLL was unhurried early, sustained a stead effort, showed some effort late on the rail and got up for the show. YOUR LUCKY TIME dueled from the outside, yielded in deep stretch and was outfinished for the show. RAMBLIN' STARR was hustled away to duel along the inside then tired. WILDCAT JACK broke outward at the break to get away slowly, raced wide throughout and placed a mild bid late. QUINTON'S FIRE was void of early speed, went five wide and sustained a mild effort. NO LATE NIGHTS saved ground to no avail. YESMAN'S SUZANNE was forwardly placed three wide then faded.
