TEXAS SILVER forced the early pace from the two path, sustained a bid at the top of the stretch, kicked clear nearing the wire drifting in late. QUICK FLAG drew quickly clear while saving ground, was challenged at the top of the stretch and failed to match strides with the winner. RUBY TEQUILA chased the early leaders along the inside and was along for the show. D J'S DIAMOND stalked the early leaders racing five wide then tired in the stretch and weakened. CARACAL ERA was outrun early, was wide in the stretch and improved his position. FANCY DOWN was unhurried early and failed to threaten. MIRACLEONTHEAVENUE trailed the field racing off the rail and was not a factor.
