### Footnotes

INITIAL T was unhurried early, circled the field in the turn five wide, sustained a bid in the stretch and kicked clear nearing the wire. SHEMYA REEF was within striking distance early, vied four wide to gain the place and was clearly the best of the rest. SHOULD was allowed to settle early saving ground, showed some effort late and was up for the show. LIZA STORM pressed the early pace, dueled in the stretch four wide and came up empty in deep stretch. R F FLYNBAYAKOA was outrun early, raced wide throughout and passed a tiring foe. ATLANTIC BREEZE was off slow early then hustled to set the pace, dueled briefly and was finished early.
