Footnotes

I THINK IT IS stalked the early leaders saving ground, angled out three wide between foes, dug in and was just up at the wire. GUILTYBYASSOCIATION was unhurried early racing off the inside, sustained a bid four wide, closed well but was out nodded at the wire. FLEETING SUMMER was allowed to settle early racing off the rail, swung out five wide at the three sixteenth, rallied in the stretch and finished well. EL TROUBADOR advanced along the inside to set the early pace, edged clear into the stretch then tired and weakened in the drive. A CLEVER DOME prompted the early pace from the outside then flattened. SIERRA SEVEN dropped back racing off the inside, was wide in the stretch and not a factor.
