TRAXSTAR pressed the early pace, moved up to gain a clear lead into the second turn, was challenged in deep stretch, fought hard, was all out at the wire and held gamely. STORMIN STORY settled into stride four wide, vied into the second turn, closed well with urging and missed. SEA BATTLE showed some early speed along the inside, lost the advantage into the backstretch, angled out to chase the early leader four wide, rallied again into the second turn but was outfinished for the place. PAY THE VIG was unhurried early along the inside and placed a mild effort. LATENITE COWBOY was void of early speed, went between foes at the eighth pole three wide and lacked a rally. POWERFUL PETE was within striking distance four wide, shifted out six wide in the stretch and was not a factor.
