BOOGER BOO set the early pace drawing clear, opened up into the stretch and pulled away late. WILDWOOD BAND prompted the early pace, lacked a gain late and followed the winner. JACOB'S CONUNDRUM stalked the early leader three wide and lacked a late response. DIXIELAND CHIME was unhurried early saving ground, sustained a brief bid then weakened. MT. FRANKLIN was outrun early, went six wide in the stretch and improved his position. KORITSIMAS KING was void of early speed and lacked a rally. DUETIME FORSUMBULL was off slow early and failed to threaten. ECHO ECHO was forwardly placed early saving ground, was in tight quarters into the turn, then steadied and gave way in the stretch. NOME G was finished early.
