PACIFIC AVENUE drew quickly clear racing off the inside, held safe advantage into the second turn then was challenged into the stretch, fought back gamely and surged clear. SEVENTYNYNINE was well back early along the inside, gained ground into the second turn, showed some effort belatedly and gained the place. PENALTY BOX chased the early leader racing off the rail, tired in the lane but held the show. POLISH GOLD was outrun early saving ground and lacked a late response. SUGARBUGA was void of early speed, went five wide and placed a mild effort. EASILY A TWELVE was forwardly placed early, went five wide and gave way. JAWBREAKER JACK showed little, went four wide and was not a threat.
